New DLE means everyone needs to learn new platform

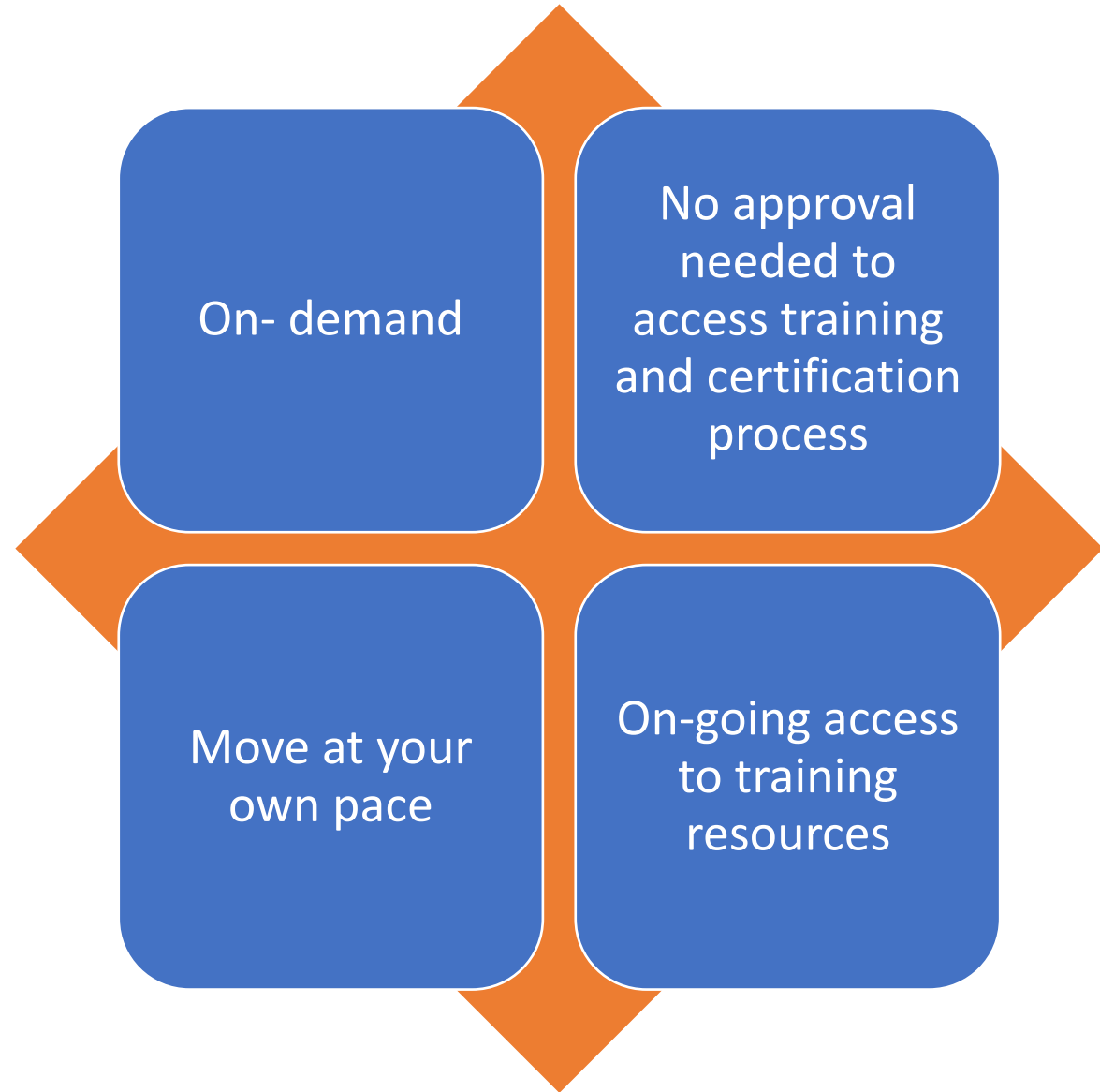
Legal requirement to make online content accessible

New Certification Content

Foundational Certification

- Core DLE
- Core Pedagogy
- Core Accessibility

Certification

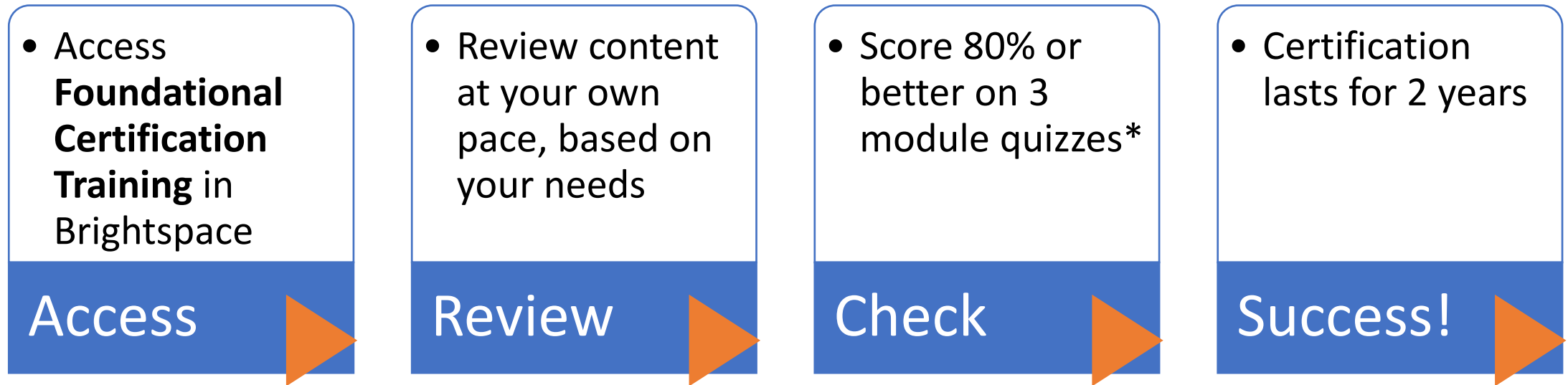
- Core Modalities
- Advanced Skills

Recertification

- Core and Skills Retest

Process for Foundational Certification

Available to all faculty



**Note: Faculty who have already completed Core DLE and Core Pedagogy are exempt from these modules and can move straight to Core Accessibility*

Process for Certification

Automatically available after Foundational Certification is Complete



Process for Recertification

Required every 4 years

- Access **Recertification Training** in Brightspace

Access

- Score 80% or better on the recertification content quiz, reviewing content, as needed

Check

- If needed, refresh a course to ensure it meets OSCQR Best Practices / EIT Standards

Refresh

- Submit course for review (available 4 times a year, limited to 30 faculty each cycle)

Submit

- Recertification lasts for 4 years
